The meeting was opened with a reading from the Acts of the Apostles followed by discussion. Jesus assures us that time is not our concern, but that the Holy Spirit would work with them with power to make us witnesses to Him in our community of faith.

Bill Paasewe presented the financial report followed by a discussion on reporting various gifts in the form of gift cards and debit cards by Valerie Curry for Family Promise administrator.

The Mortgage Committee needs members now also as the mortgage has to be refinanced by October of this year. Let Jennifer know if interested.

Ministry Head planning meeting is June 21. Fr Fabio will be sending out an email about the work that needs to be done before the meeting.
